

## INTRODUCTION

**B**ursaries of \$700 are awarded to High School graduates pursuing post-secondary education at a university, a community college or in an apprenticeship program. The recipients are selected by a committee of five:

- ◆ The Incumbent
- ◆ A Church Warden
- ◆ The Chair of the Outreach Committee
- ◆ A member nominated by the Fellows of St. Paul's

## ELIGIBILITY

**T**he bursary is open to St. Paul's youths who are pursuing post-secondary studies.

## APPLYING

**A**n application can be made by:

- ◆ Completing an application form, available online or from the office;
- ◆ Submitting a written statement of not more than 300 words in support of the application, clearly indicating why the applicant should be awarded the bursary;
- ◆ Submitting a copy of the acceptance letter, or relevant documentation, from the educational institution in which the applicant is enrolled;
- ◆ The application form and statement should be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked "Bursary Program", and delivered to the church office on or before the annual deadline of August 31.
- ◆ Ordinarily, the bursaries are awarded on Thanksgiving Sunday.
